Construction Update

Construction works onsite at the Girgarre Solar Farm are progressing well. Piling, which forms part of the mounting structure has been completed. Construction of foundations for power stations and substation are continuing, as well as the electrical cable installation. Additionally, the solar PV module installation has commenced and will continue over the next few months.

Light and heavy vehicles continue to transit Morrissey Road, Watson Road, Winter Road and Mason Road as goods and personnel are transported to site.

During the upcoming weeks, Heavy Rigid trucks with containers of solar PV modules will continue to transit to and from site on the Girgarre-Rushworth Road (C348) and the Midland Highway (A300).
