



# Girgarre Solar Farm – Monthly Project Update

## Construction Update

The construction of the Girgarre Solar Farm has an investment value of over \$140 million. The estimated construction timeframe for the plant is expected to be approximately 18 months, while the plant's operational life is estimated at approximately 35 years.

The construction phase will commence in the upcoming weeks of September/October 2023.

The relevant Development Approvals for the Girgarre Solar Farm have been obtained from the Campaspe Shire Council. The planning approval sets out conditions for the project, including management plans. Management systems will be in place to ensure compliance with all conditions covering construction, operation, decommissioning, and administrative matters.

EGP hired Beon Energy Solutions to manage the construction works for the project as Principal Contractor. EGP will work closely with Beon Energy Solutions to identify capability and capacity in the local area and maximise opportunities for local contractors and suppliers to participate in the project through goods and services provision to both the project site and workforce.
