

Girgarre Solar Farm – Monthly Project Update

Construction Update

Construction works onsite at the Girgarre Solar Farm are progressing well. Piling, mounting structure assembly, and PV module installation has been completed. Construction of foundations for power stations are continuing, as well as the electrical cable installation. The AC and DC trenching activity is completed.

Additionally, the substation construction is ongoing, and the Operations & Maintenace building works have commenced.

Light vehicles continue to transit Morrissey Road, Watson Road, Winter Road and Mason Road as goods and personnel are transported to site.

From Port Melbourne to the Project site, trucks with containers of electrical equipment will be transiting the Girgarre-Rushworth Road and Midland Highway in the upcoming weeks.

On 10th April 2024, the Minister for Prevention of Family Violence and Minister for Employment Vicki Ward visited Girgarre Solar Farm. During the visit, Minister Ward had the opportunity to speak to local workers about their experience working on the solar farm, and how this has provided opportunities to gain skills in a growing and rapidly changing evolving industry.
