



Construction Update – February 2026

Construction activities

Construction of the Quorn Park Solar Hybrid farm in Parkes NSW is progressing well, with a significant project milestone recently reached.

On Friday, 20 February, the final solar panels were installed on site. In total, more than 161,000 panels have been installed over the past six months.

The project is now in its commissioning phase and is undertaking rigorous electrical testing, validation and compliance checks to ensure the facility operates safely and efficiently in accordance with regulatory and safety standards, before finalising export profile to the grid. Commissioning activities will continue over the coming months.

Remaining construction activities are expected to be completed in the upcoming weeks, with full generation anticipated in the last quarter of 2026.

Construction hours remain from Monday to Friday 7:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturday 7:00am to 1:00pm. All construction works are undertaken in accordance with the conditions of the Development Approval and relevant legislative requirements.

Once complete, the project will be the first large-scale solar and battery hybrid power plant connected to Australia's main grid. Integrating battery storage with the solar farm allows energy generated during the day to be stored on site and dispatched to the grid in the evening, helping to meet peak demand.

When fully operational, the facility will generate enough clean energy to power approximately 45,000 homes.

Beon Energy Solutions, the EPC contractor for the project, has maintained a strong focus on local employment. At peak workforce levels, 63% of the mechanical workforce was sourced locally from Parkes and Peak Hill, with 23% identifying as Aboriginal.

Beon Energy Solutions' Women in Solar pre-employment program has also created meaningful pathways for local women to enter the renewable energy sector, with women comprising approximately 30% of the mechanical workforce.
