



### Construction Update – May 2026

#### Construction activities

The Quorn Park Solar Hybrid farm is now fully commissioned. Network integration tests are ongoing for compliance and to ensure the facility operates safely and efficiently within agreed network parameters. The plant is expected to reach full operational capacity by the last quarter of 2026.

Construction hours remain from Monday to Friday 7:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturday 7:00am to 1:00pm. All construction works are undertaken in accordance with the conditions of the Development Approval and relevant legislative requirements.

Once complete, the project will be the first large-scale solar and battery hybrid power plant connected to Australia's main grid, allowing concurrent operations of both solar and BESS. Integrating battery storage with the solar farm allows energy generated during the day to be stored on site and dispatched to the grid in the evening, helping to meet peak demand.

When fully operational, the facility will generate enough clean energy to power approximately 45,000 homes.

With the completion of construction and commencement of demobilisation the frequency of community updates will reduce.

Potentia Energy remains committed to notifying stakeholders of any major project milestones, and will continue to engage with the community respectfully and transparently.
