Construction Update – October 2025

Construction activities

Construction of the Quorn Park Solar Hybrid Farm in Parkes NSW is progressing well.

Mechanical crews completed the installation of the tracking system last month, which allows the solar panels to follow the sun's movement and maximise energy production throughout the day. Over 25 percent, or around 45,000 solar panels, have been installed at Quorn Park site to date.

The delivery of the Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) is expected in the coming weeks, marking an important construction milestone.

Construction hours continue from Monday to Friday 7:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturday 7:00am to 1:00pm. All construction works are undertaken in accordance with the conditions of the Development Approval and relevant legislative requirements.

Road upgrades and traffic

Road upgrades to Henry Parkes Way and McGrath Lane are complete and the intersection upgrade is ongoing. Vehicle movements are being continuously monitored to minimise impacts to local road users.

Light and heavy vehicles will continue along Henry Parkes Way, McGrath Lane, and Back Trundle Road as materials and personnel are transported to site in accordance with the approved Traffic Management Plan, generally between 7.00am – 6.00pm Monday to Friday.
