Commissioning Activities

Over the past two months, the Flat Rocks Wind Farm Stage 1 (FRWF1) project has completed the installation of the last Wind Turbine Generator (WTG) and successfully conducted the second round of grid compliance tests together with Australian **Energy Market Operator and Western** Power. The Noise Monitoring Campaign is due to start in late April (date to be finalised in the coming weeks) for a minimum period of 6 weeks, in order to capture representative data in different environmental conditions and different wind speed and directions, in accordance with the approved NIMMP (Noise Impact Monitoring Management Plan).
